The Board of Directors of Saints' Roost Museum has set the date for the 26<sup>th</sup> Annual Col. Charles Goodnight Chuck Wagon Cook Off for Saturday, September 26, 2020. We invite you to participate by returning the registration form enclosed. The following information might be helpful to you in making the decision to compete:

- Wagon deposit will be \$100.00 per wagon (*Refunded on arrival*).
- **\$100 will be paid to each wagon upon arrival to help defray travel expenses.**
- **Registration deadline is August 1<sup>st</sup>** to confirm number of wagons and allow pre-sale of tickets to the public. Space for 16 wagons.
- Set-up on Friday, September 25, 2020 on the museum grounds, HWY 70 South
- Cook's meeting Friday 3:00 pm
- Wagon judging Friday 3:30 pm
- Campsites and wagons judged based on authenticity.
- Cook's Dinner Friday 6:30 pm
- Junior Cook Off competition on Friday afternoon/evening to promote the art of chuck wagon cooking. We hope that each wagon will participate in this fun event by mentoring a young cook. Junior participants will prepare potatoes (using any recipe) to be judged and then served at the Cook's Dinner Friday evening. **Bring your favorite potato recipe to share with a junior cook.**
- On Saturday, each wagon will prepare a menu of chicken fried steak, beans, biscuits, mashed potatoes, and peach cobbler. (Meat will be distributed to the wagon already cut and tenderized and peaches will be canned). Each wagon will provide 40 meals for the public.
- **The meal will be served at 1:00 pm, Saturday.** Awards will be at 3:00 pm.
- Conversation wood will be provided for your fires.
- Parking area will be provided for trailers away from the cookoff area.

\$3250 in prize money will be given away. Qualified judges will determine winners.
