### Host Wagon Instructions

Contestants and host wagons will be matched by draw on\_\_\_\_\_.

Parents or other "advisors" are NOT allowed in the host camp after competition begins. Anyone other than the host wagon cook(s) in the camp during the competition will result in disqualification. We will try to monitor at the start of the cooking. If you have a problem, please send for one of us and we will help rectify the situation.

Cobblers are to be cooked, with the help of the host wagon cook(s) and only the host wagon cook(s), on the premises using wood fires and dutch ovens. You may use liners if you would like.

A basic recipe and ingredients are provided along with a small container for the judges' sample. The recipe is to be followed but contestants may add their own spices and/or seasonings true to the chuck wagon era (cinnamon, nutmeg, vanilla, etc.) to "personalize" your entry. No nuts, pie crust, alcohol, or additional fruit is to be used.

**Please remember, this is the junior cook's competition, not yours.** You may be helpful, but it is to be their recipe and their effort.

Entries will be picked up for judging on\_\_\_\_\_. Junior cooks are to help serve and clean up.
